

The University of Zurich and ETH Zurich are holding an essay contest on the topic "Humans and artificial intelligence in the year 2050." Each class may submit up to three works for one of the two categories "Essay" and "Group Work."

Competition for school classes

The University of Zurich and ETH Zurich are awarding prizes for essays and group works on the topic "Humans and artificial intelligence in the year 2050."

Categories

The competition features the two categories "Essay" and "Group Work." Each class may submit works for one of the two categories.

Essay Category (individual work)

Assignment

Individual students are asked to write an essay within a time limit of 120 minutes.

Format:

Please use A4 letter size sheets, written on only one side (may be submitted in English).

Group Work Category

Assignment

In a group of up to six individuals, students are to produce a collage/sculpture within a time limit of 240 minutes Format:

No preset specifications

Prizes

1st prize

Visit to Technorama, Winterthur (for the whole class)

2nd and 3rd prizes

An expedition to the University of Zurich/ETH Zurich plus Ada T-shirts for all students or 600 Swiss francs for the classroom fund plus Ada T-shirts for all students

4th to 10th prizes

300 Swiss francs for the classroom fund

Conditions of participation

Participation is limited to school classes in Switzerland. A maximum of three essays or three group works may be submitted per class (a class may submit entries for only one category). The works must be written or produced under the supervision of a teacher.

The winners shall be notified in writing. Prize-winning essays and group works are to be identified by name and published on the University of Zurich/ETH Zurich website and may be exhibited in the main building of ETH Zurich. Submissions will not be returned. The University of Zurich/ETH Zurich will enter into no correspondence about the contest. Any recourse to courts of law is excluded.

Submission deadlines and addresses

Submission deadlines are 15 July 2002 and 30 September 2002 (date of postmark). The works are to be submitted along with the official form to
